Participants learn the art and techniques of hand-drumming and improvisation alongside the chance to select recycled and natural found objects and explore them for the sound properties they possess, assembling and playing instruments or sound sculptures of their own design.

Ricardo Frota is a Brazilian musician, performer and music educator who graduated from the New England Conservatory, Boston. He is the creator of "Ecology of Sound," a multicultural music program for children that uses traditional music instruments as well invented instruments made from recycled and natural objects.
